B. Discussion and Motions Regarding Purchasing Policy

The LSVCOG members discussed utilizing DCED's purchasing handbook as their policy document.

C. Fueling Station Items for Discussion and Motions - Mr. Guesto discussed the initial rollout of the fueling station, thanking Mr. Ritsick, Mr. Colarusso and Mr. Yodsnukis for their work. Mr. Ritsick discussed that every individual would have a PIN number and each vehicle would need a key fob to take fuel.

Individuals need to reach out to Mr. Ritsick with any changes, and provide a point person for administrative tasks. Mr. Guesto emphasized the importance of housekeeping by all members such as plowing when necessary, taking out garbage, and being good stewards of the facility. Road and perimeter lighting was ordered and fill was also procured for the road leading up to the facility. COG members also discussed the training of operators for the fueling station.

- **a.** Earth Conservancy Special Project Donation Mr. Guesto and Mr. Ostrowski discussed the different insurance required for Earth Conservancy participating in the project as they are not a municipal entity. No motion was made on this topic.
- b. Fueling Station Bank Account COG members discussed the fueling station bank account and signers for the account at People's Security. Signers would be Donna Wall, Joe Hillan and Jen Polito. No motions were made on this topic.
